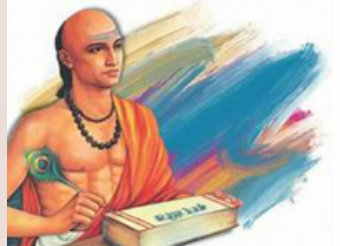
ARYABHATA : MATHEMATICIAN OF THE YEAR
