**About:**

After completing his schooling from DPSG Meerut Road, Yogesh pursued a B.Com degree from MMH College, Ghaziabad and later joined his family business, Sudha Ispat Pvt. Ltd., which is a reputed name in iron trading since 1987. In 1998, he took a significant step by establishing its first manufacturing unit, Sudha Steel, in Bulandshahr Industrial Area with a production capacity of 400 metric tons per month. As his business expanded, he relocated it to Chhapraula, Gautam Buddh Nagar, under the new identity Sudha Steel Manufacturer Pvt. Ltd., enhancing its capacity to 1,500 metric tons. Today, in 2025, its production capacity has grown to 10,000 metric tons per month.

Alongside business, he has been actively involved in social work, contributing to organisations like Bharat Vikas Parishad, the Ramlila Committee of Raj Nagar, and the Gaushala in Ghaziabad. He also regularly supports old age homes and various charitable initiatives, believing deeply in giving back to the community.

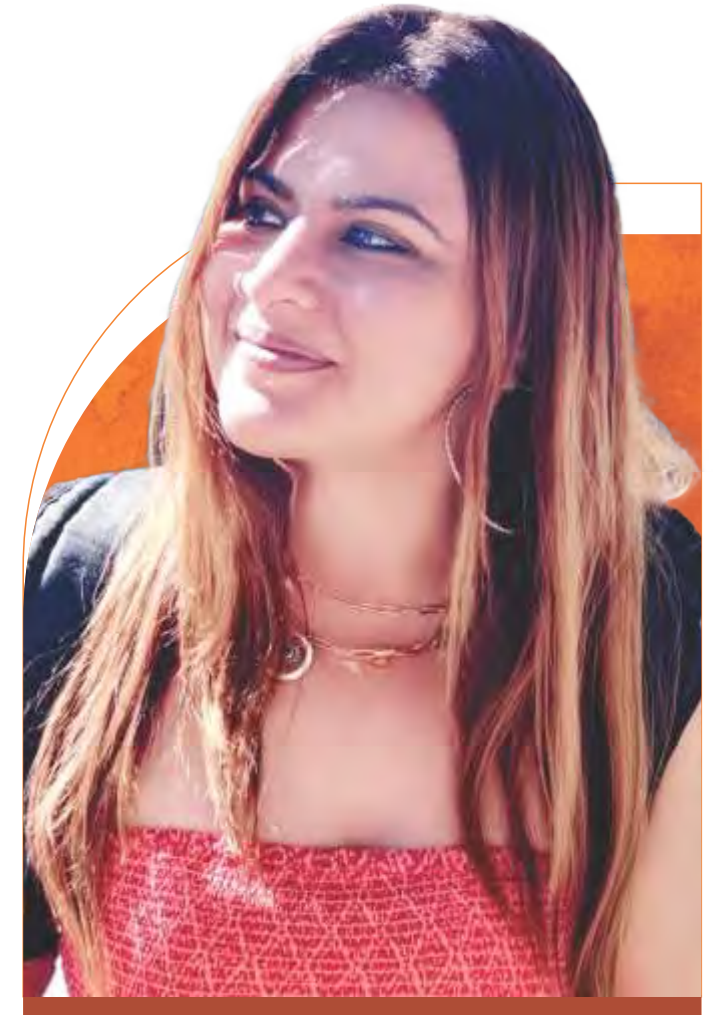

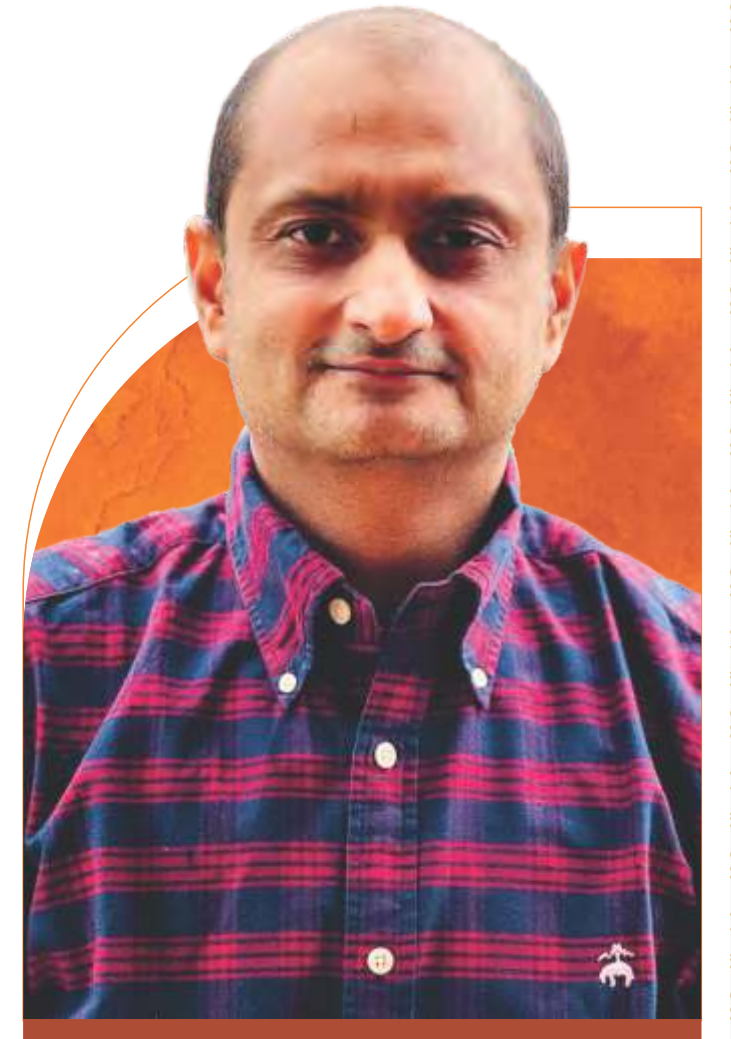

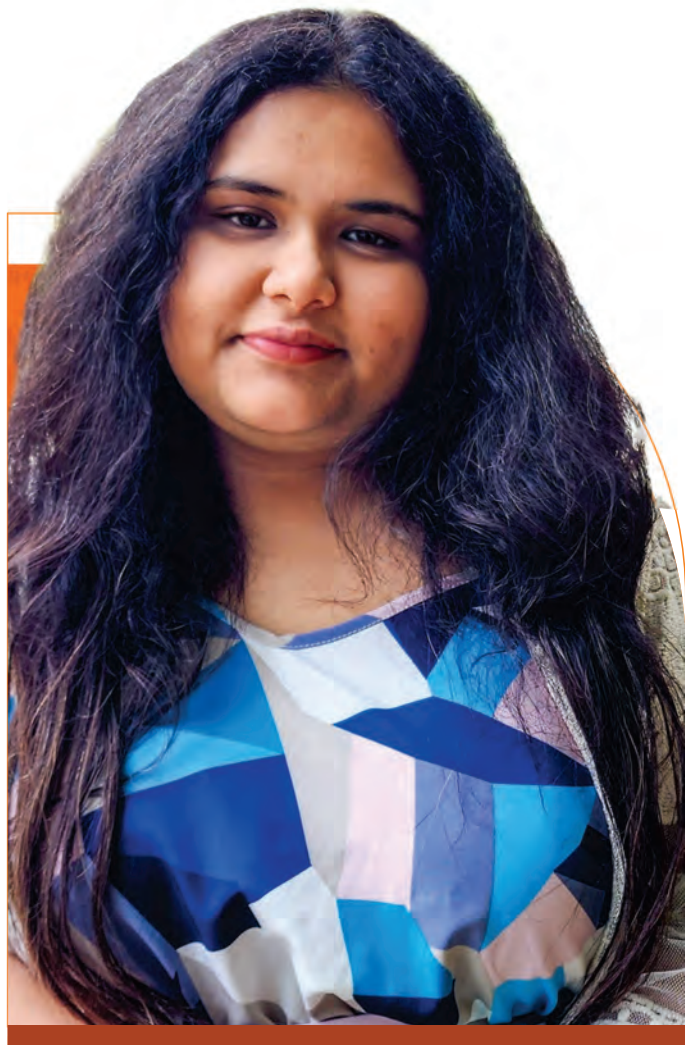
