## AI & MACHINE LEARNING ENGINEER

Designs intelligent systems that learn from data and make decisions without human intervention. Widely used in self-driving cars, facial recognition, healthcare, and predictive analytics.

Turns raw data into meaningful insights that drive strategic decisions for businesses. Works with tools like Python, SQL, and machine learning to solve real-world problems.

## PODCAST PRODUCER / AUDIO CONTENT CREATOR

Creates, edits, and curates engaging audio content for podcasts, audiobooks, and brands. Involves storytelling, scriptwriting, sound editing, and platform distribution strategy.
