- Applications for CLAT, SLAT, and other law exams are now live. The last date for CLAT is October 22, 2025.

## **AI Skills Shortage in India**

- A recent report shows that for every 10 AI jobs, only 1 qualified engineer is available, underlining the urgent need for tech upskilling.
