LAW: CLAT DATES FOR 2023 INTAKE

The Consortium of National Law Universities has released an official notification along with the registration form for CLAT 2023, August 08, 2022. It has opened the CLAT 2023 examination portal where candidates can register themselves to get the latest updates on dates, application form and patterns and syllabus. The CLAT 2023 application form is available at the official website consortiumofnlus.ac.in. The last date to fill the CLAT application form 2023 is November 13, 2022. The CLAT 2023 will be conducted on December 18, 2022, in offline mode. This is for the first time that the Common Law Admission Test or CLAT will be as early as December instead of its usual time, i.e., the first week of May.

ASHOKA UNIVERSITY OPENS APPLICATION FOR AUGUST 2023

The online registrations have started for the August 2023 intake. The interested candidates can apply for the desired course by visiting the Ashoka University official website (apply.ashoka.edu.in). Ashoka University offers over 35 courses at UG, PG and PhD levels through its 19 departments and 12 centres. Admission to most of the courses is based on an assessment followed by an interview with the panel.

USA: COMMON APP LAUNCHES 2022-2023 APPLICATION

The Common Application is an undergraduate college admission application that applicants may use to apply to any of more than 950 member colleges and universities in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, as well as in Canada, China, Japan, and many European countries. Common Applaunches 2022–2023 application with more than 1,000 colleges and universities on 1st August 2022. Students applying to college in 2022–2023 will also have access to nearly 70 new colleges and universities.

OXBRIDGE: OXFORD & CAMBRIDGE DEADLINE?

The deadline for Oxbridge applications is earlier than the standard UCAS deadline (26th January 2022 for 2022 entry and 25th January 2023 for 2023 entry). Your whole Oxbridge application, including your personal statement, registration for admissions test(s) and references, must be submitted by the 15th October. This deadline remains the same from year to year
