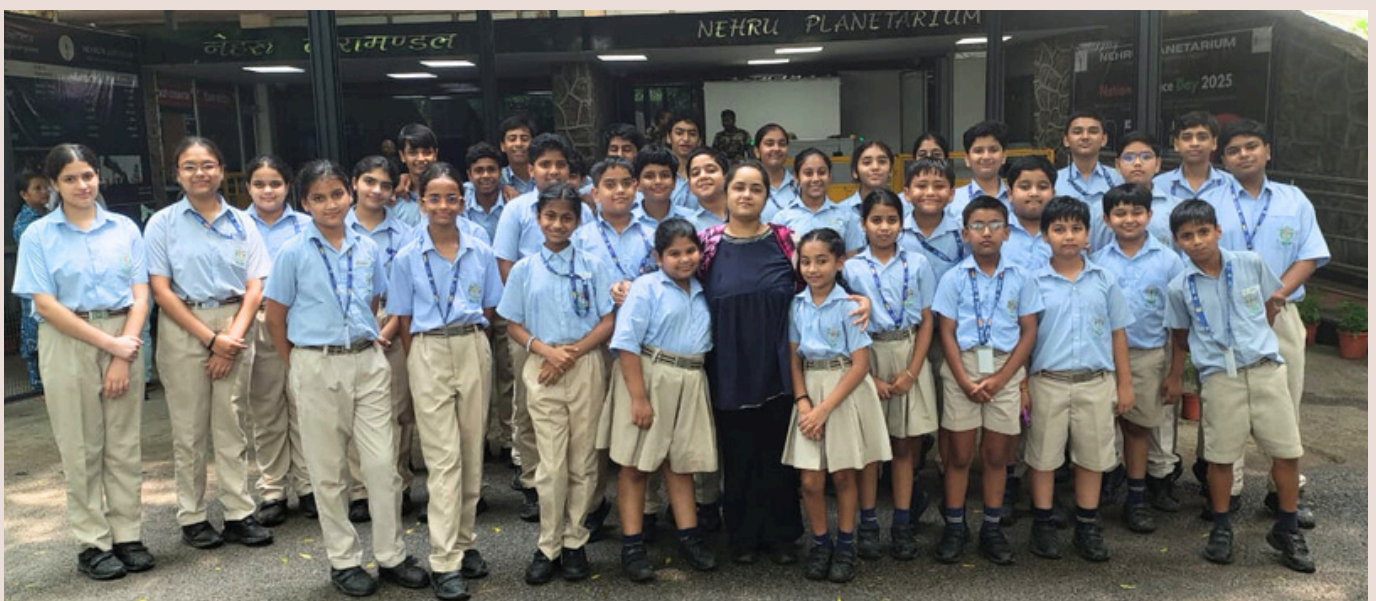
EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO NEHRU PLANETARIUM

Summary:

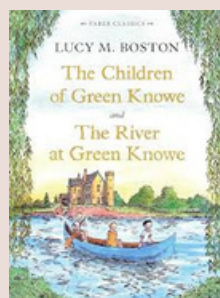
