# The Interplay of Knowledge and Perspective: A Grand Showcase at the TOK Exhibition 2024

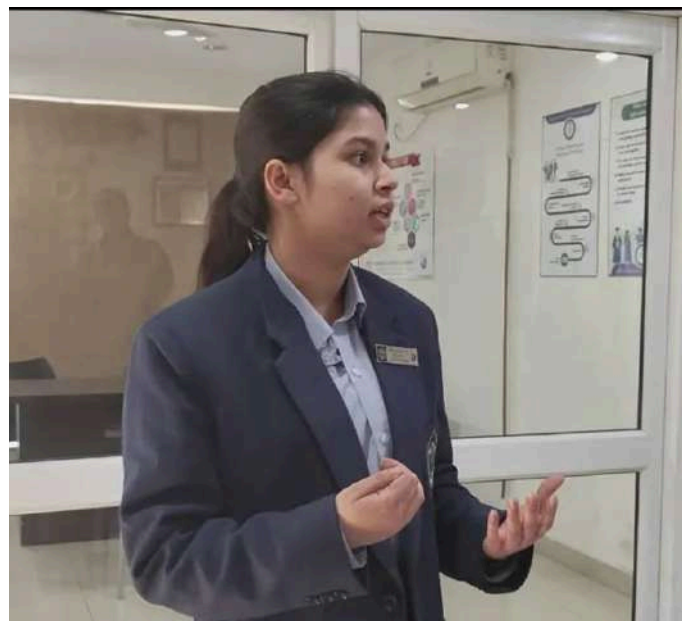

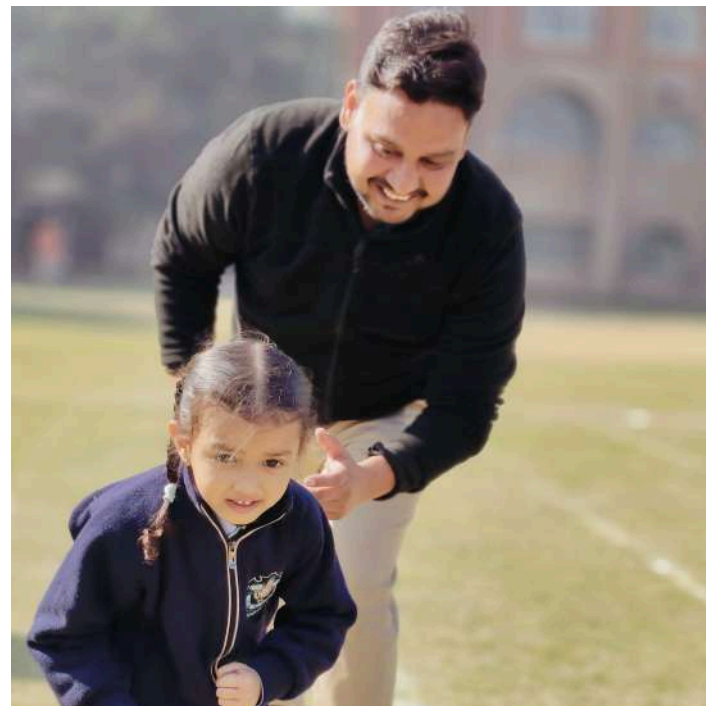
## Building Strength and Spirit: Annual Sports Day
