DT'S Amey Mittal caught up with Ms. Neitu Singh Malik, for a Q&A session



Mrs. Neitu Singh Malik, PGT Geography & Geospatial Technology

Q.1 Remote Sensing is a technical subject. How did you ensure that students found it engaging and easy to understand?

Remote Sensing, though technical, has real-world applications that students can easily relate to. To make the topic engaging, I started with simple, relatable examples—such as using Google Maps on a mobile phone.

Q2. Since this was a live session on PM eVidya, what strategies did you use to maintain student engagement?

In an online format, maintaining engagement is crucial. I focused on visual learning, using satellite images, before-and-after scenarios of environmental changes, and deforestation tracking.

Q3. What challenges did you face while conducting this session, and how did you overcome them?

One of the biggest challenges in an online setting is the lack of real-time interaction with students. Unlike a classroom, I couldn't get their immediate responses. For this, I used real-world problem-solving scenarios to explain complex ideas.

Q4. What message would you like to give to students who want to learn more about Remote Sensing and Geospatial Technology?

I would say, stay curious and explore the world through data! There are many free tools like Google Earth Engine, and Sentinel Hub where students can experiment with real satellite imagery.
