The academic session 2026–27 is well underway, and it is heartening to see our



students engaged with renewed energy, curiosity, and a clear sense of purpose. The positive rhythm across classrooms reflects a promising year ahead, filled with opportunities for meaningful learning and growth. We are delighted to share that the CBSE Grade 10 Results for the session 2025–26 have been excellent. Our students have performed exceptionally well, upholding the school's tradition of academic excellence. We are especially proud of **Jigyansh Sengar**, who emerged as the school topper with an outstanding 98.8%. This remarkable achievement reflects the students' sustained hard work, the dedicated mentorship of our teachers, and the constant support and encouragement of parents.

We are proud to celebrate the outstanding CBSE Grade 10 Results 2026. Out of 454 students who appeared for the examination, 189 students scored 90% and above. Among them, 11 students secured 97% and above, while 36 students achieved 95% and above. Additionally, students earned an impressive 40 perfect scores (100/100) across various subjects, reflecting their hard work, perseverance, and the relentless support and guidance of teachers and parents alike.

Our students continue to excel in national and international Olympiads, securing 48 Gold Medals in SOF Olympiads along with Medals of Excellence and Distinction. Students also earned several national, zonal, state, and school-level recognitions in Silver Zone and Unified Council examinations. At DWPS MUN 5.0, our students brought laurels to the school with honours such as Best Delegate and High Commendation.

DPSG Cup 2026 was another proud achievement, with over 950 athletes from 43+ institutions participating in the event hosted at DPSG Meerut Road. DPSG MR emerged as the Overall Champion and secured victories in Athletics, Chess, and Shooting.

The recently conducted Parent–Teacher Conference strengthened the partnership between parents and teachers in nurturing every child's growth. At DPSG MR, we remain committed to holistic education that builds values, discipline, confidence, and excellence, guiding our learners towards a brighter future.

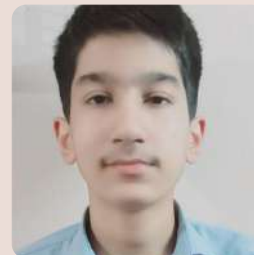

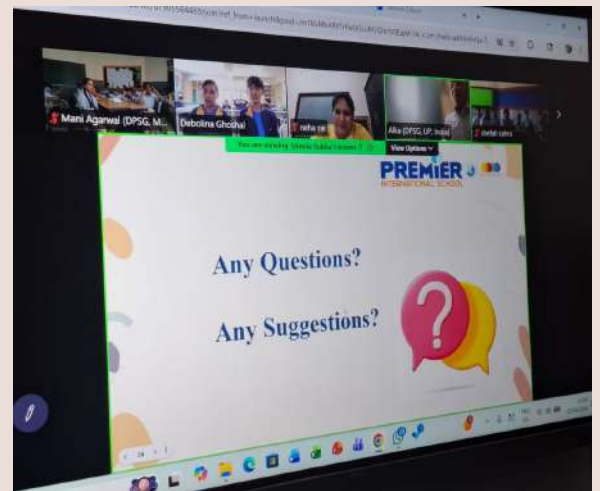
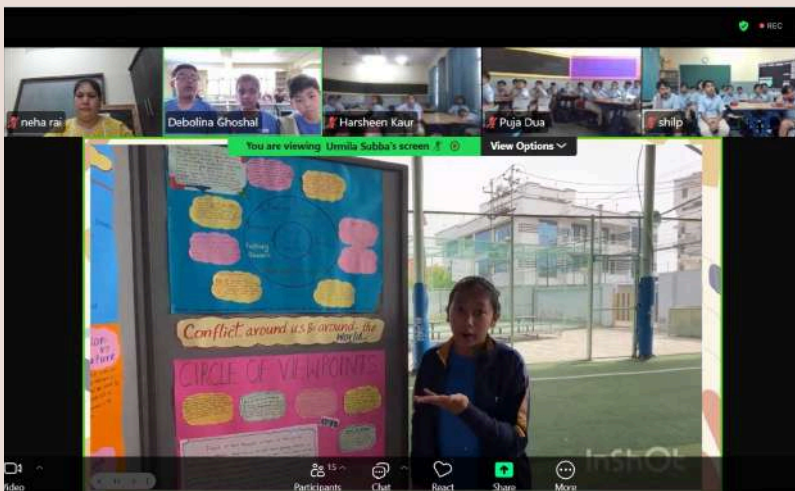
