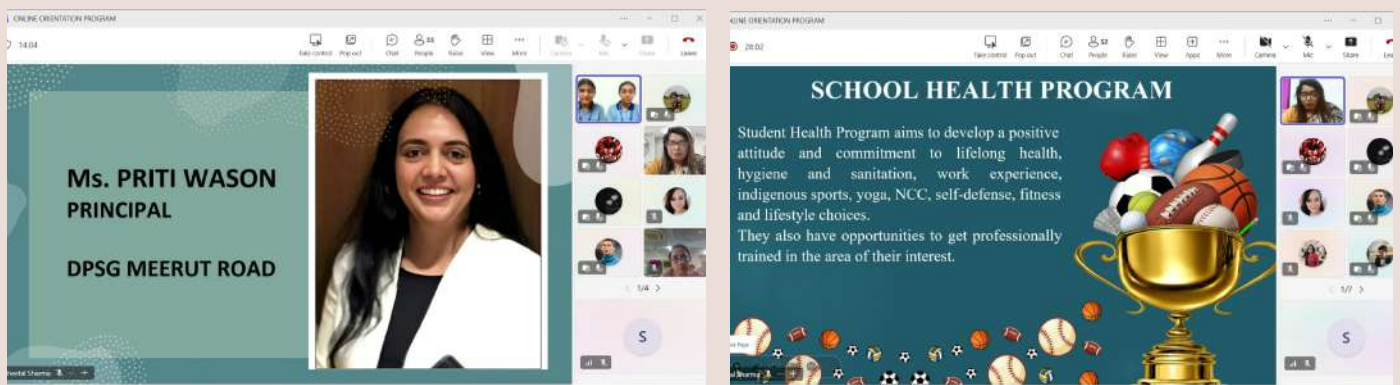


Empowering Educators

An Adventure to Remember: Grade 5 Trip to Jim Corbett

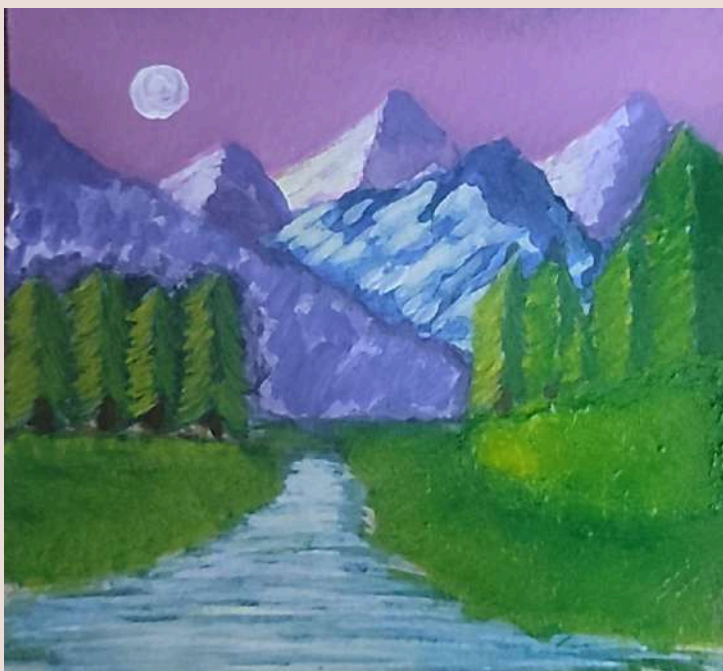

The Invisible Ladder We All Climb

Social stratification is not just about wealth; it is about how inequality disguises itself as merit. Bourdieu showed that elite families transmit "cultural capital" — specific speech patterns, confidence, and taste — that get mistaken for individual talent, allowing privilege to circulate while appearing earned. India's caste system and America's racial wealth gap are extreme versions of the same mechanic: stratification hardens across generations because the criteria for success are written by those at the top, for those at the top. The system does not need to be conspiratorial to be unjust. It just needs to keep calling unequal outcomes natural.

In peace and balance, wild and free."

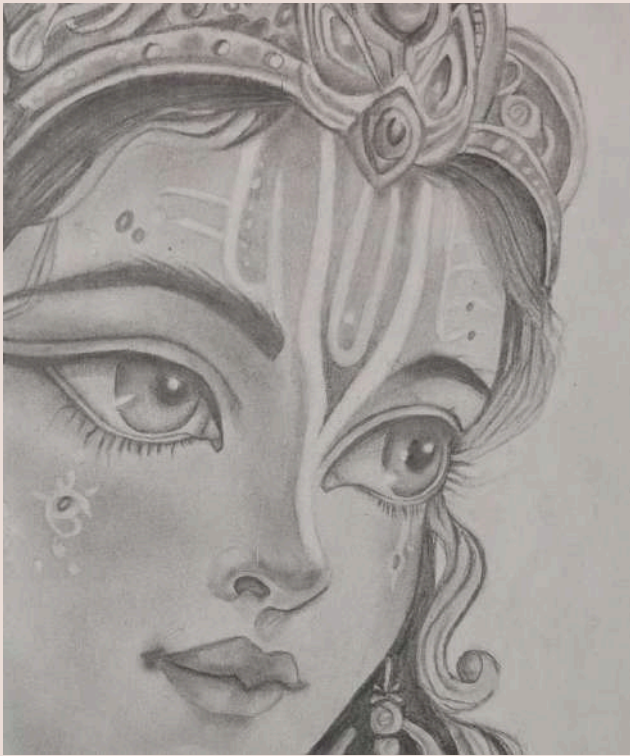

Life

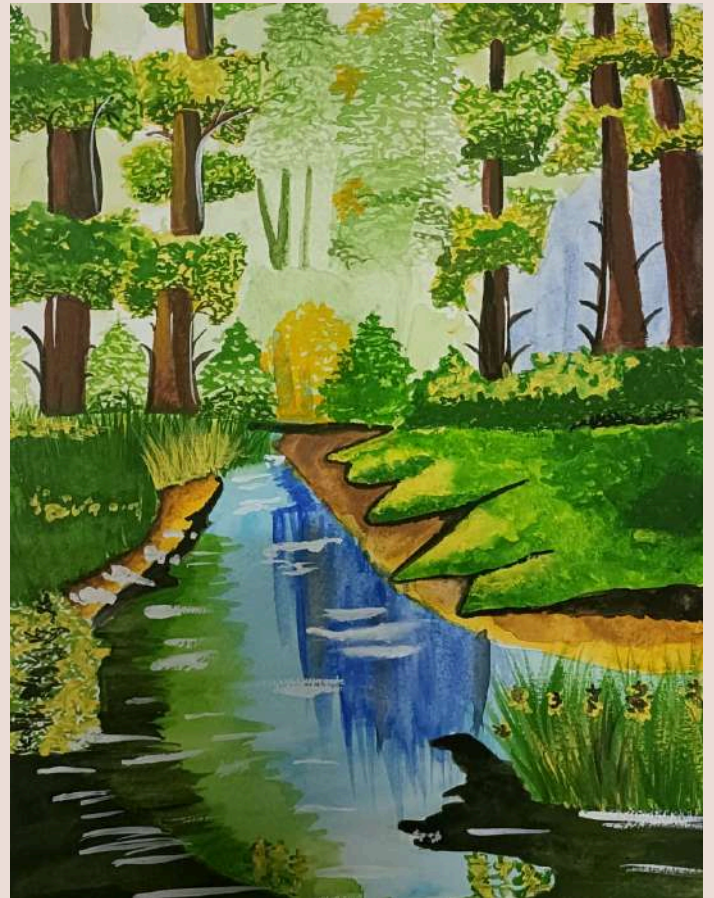
"Life, as it is
