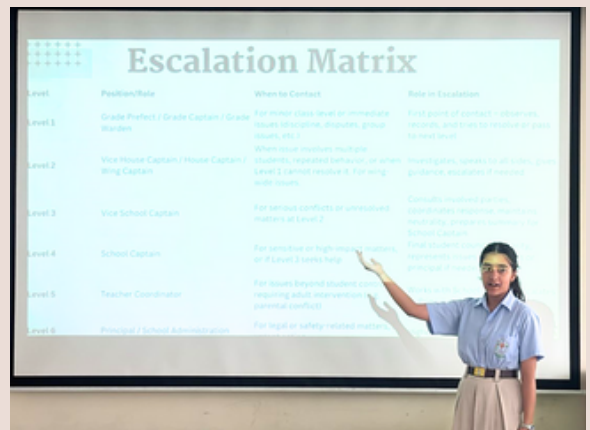
DISCOVER. REFLECT. LEAD.

LEARNING THROUGH CELEBRATIONS



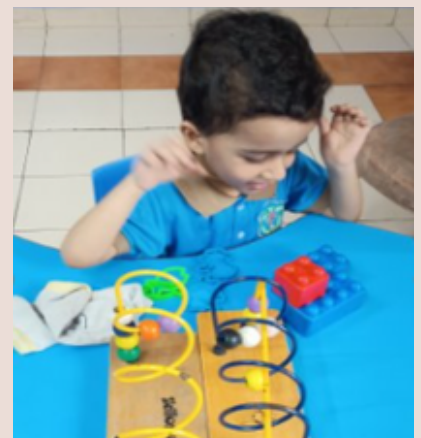
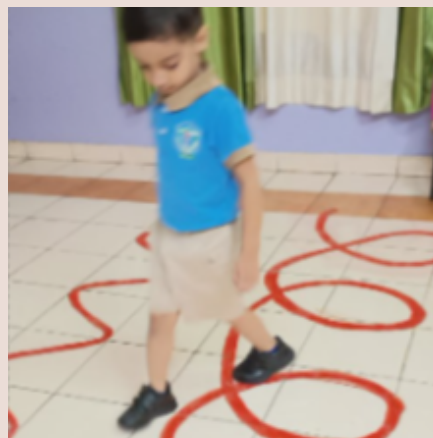
