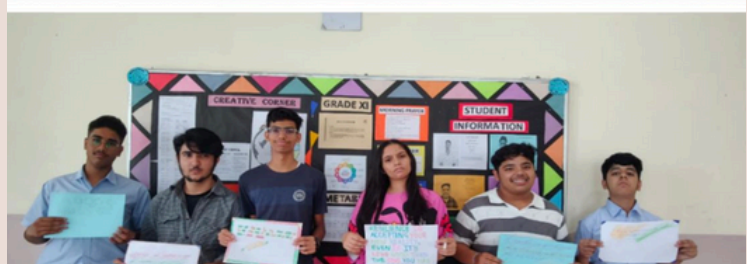
Day 4: Heads-up
